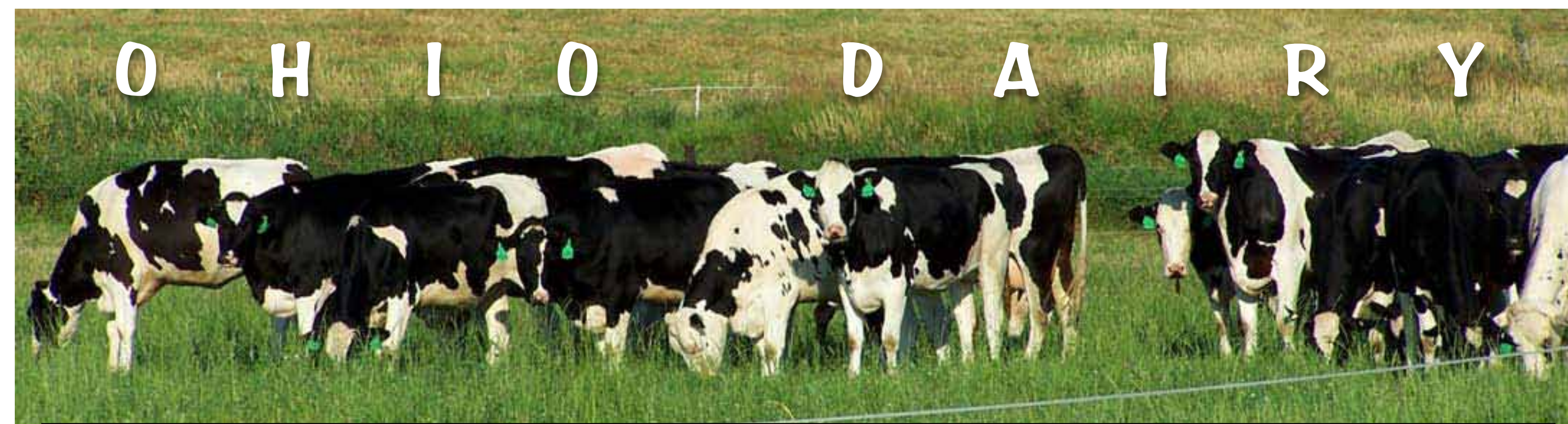

## Ohio Dairy

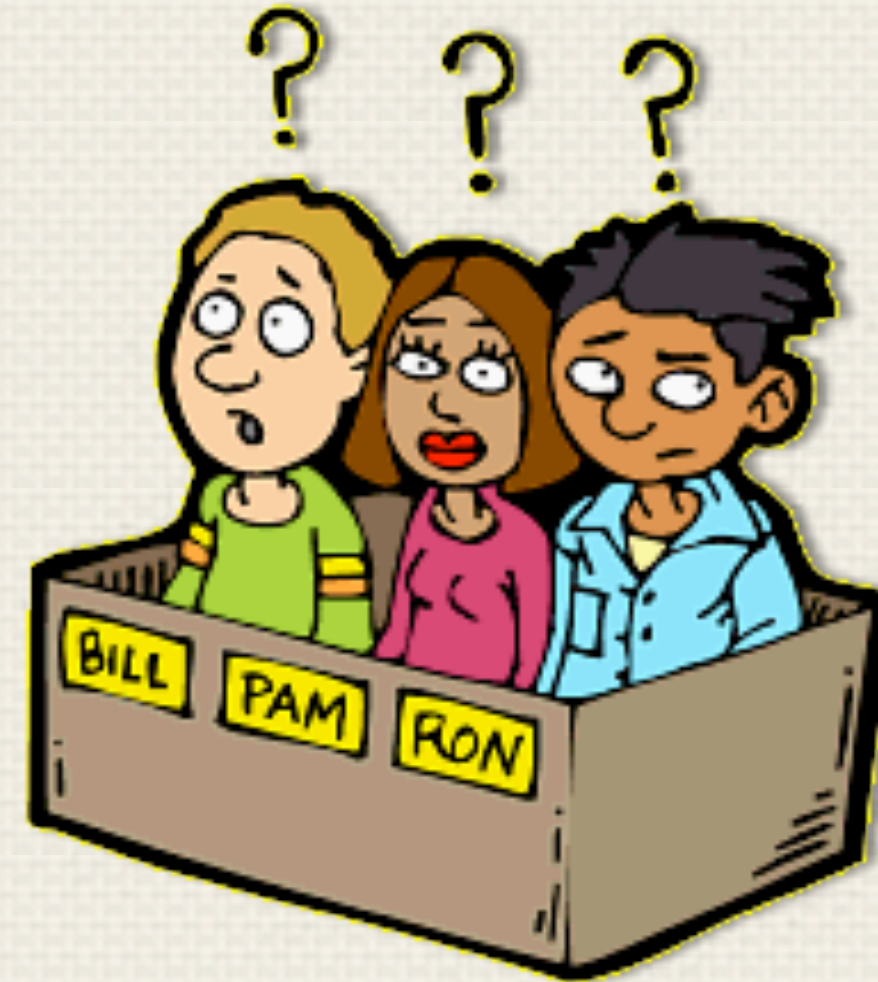
